


Emergency and massive disaster management in dialysis units during the procedure of hemodialysis

How many of your patients are familiar with the contents of your plan? Are you sure?

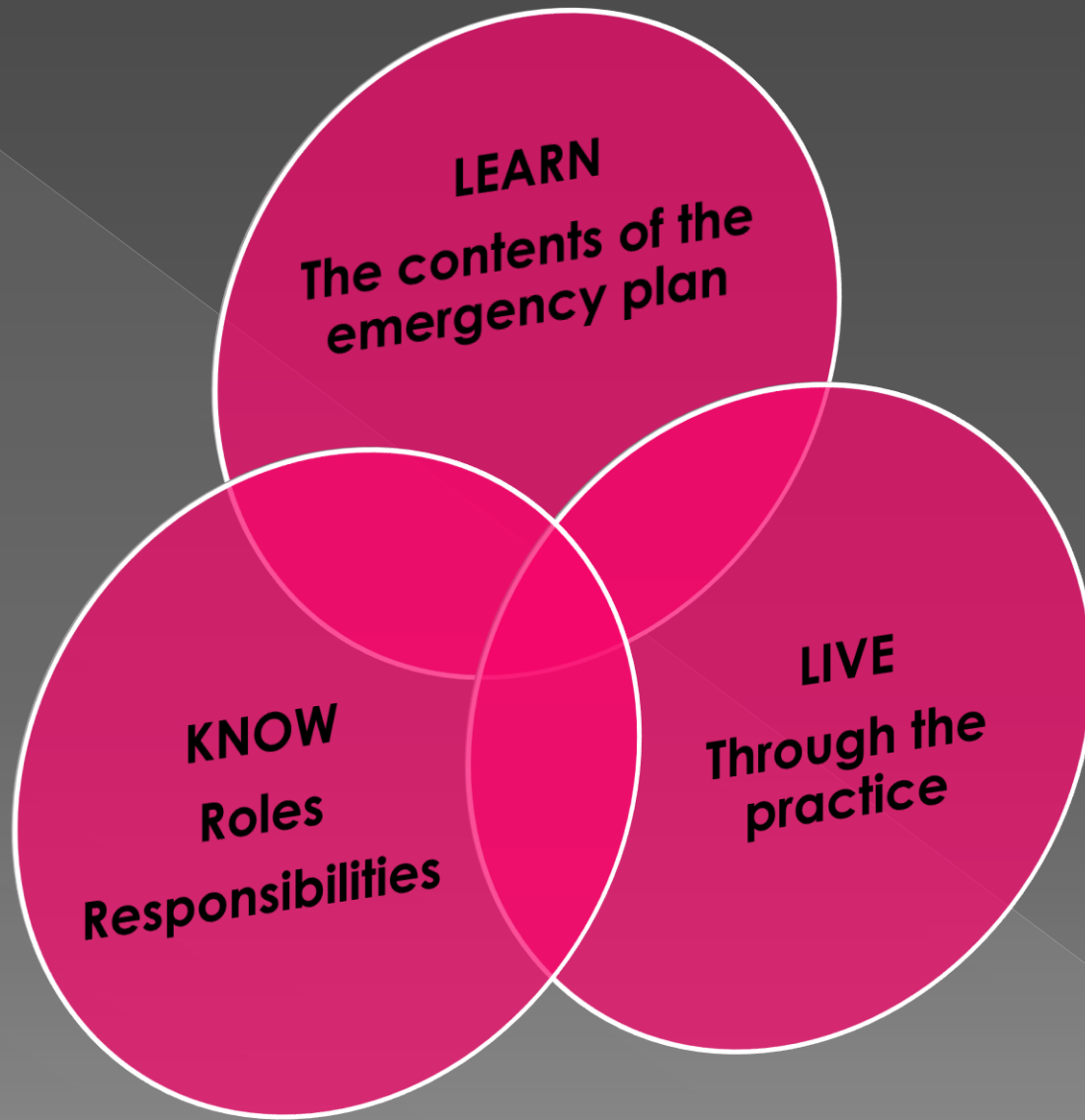
In our hemodialysis unit of G.H. Papageorgiou we have begun an effort to
